

Tips to Help You Get the Most Out of Your **CADUET Savings Card***



Tips for the doctor's office

1. Remind your doctor to write "CADUET"—and not the generic—on your prescription
2. Make sure your prescription says "Dispense As Written (DAW)" or "No Substitutions," as per your state's requirement



Tips for dropping off your prescription at the pharmacy

1. Ask your pharmacist to run your prescription with the CADUET Savings Card, following the directions on the back of the card, while you wait
2. If your pharmacist needs help processing your card, he or she can call 1-877-612-1148



Tips for picking up your prescription at the pharmacy

1. Check your bag at the pharmacy counter to make sure you received brand-name CADUET and your savings
2. If you did not get CADUET, tell your pharmacist right away

Treatment Reminders

If you and your doctor have chosen CADUET as part of your treatment plan, it should be taken as prescribed. Call your pharmacy to check that you have refills left. If no refills remain, call your doctor right away to ask if you need to renew your prescription.

Terms and Conditions

By using the CADUET® (amlodipine besylate/atorvastatin calcium) Savings Card, you acknowledge that you currently meet the eligibility criteria and will comply with the terms and conditions described below:

- The Card is not valid for prescriptions that are eligible to be reimbursed, in whole or in part, by Medicaid, Medicare, or other federal or state healthcare programs (including any state prescription drug assistance programs and the Government Health Insurance Plan available in Puerto Rico [formerly known as “La Reforma De Salud”])
- The Card is not valid for prescriptions that are eligible to be reimbursed by private insurance plans or other health or pharmacy benefit programs that reimburse you for the entire cost of your prescription drugs
- Patients must be 18 or older
- By using the Card, patients will pay a minimum of \$4 per refill and receive savings of up to \$150 per refill. The Card is good for a maximum savings of \$1800 per calendar year
- You must deduct the value received under this program from any reimbursement request submitted to your insurance plan, either directly by you or on your behalf
- The Card is not valid for Massachusetts residents whose prescriptions are covered in whole or in part by third-party insurance, or where otherwise prohibited by law
- The Card cannot be combined with any other rebate or coupon, free trial, or similar offer for the specified prescription
- **The Card will be accepted only at participating pharmacies**
- **The Card is not health insurance**
- This offer is good only in the United States and Puerto Rico
- The Card is limited to one per person during this offering period and is not transferable
- Pfizer reserves the right to rescind, revoke, or amend the Card without notice
- The Card expires on December 31, 2018. No membership fees apply
